All applicants must be at least 18 years old and are required to provide proof of Firearms Safety Training.

You must send a copy of your firearms safety training certificate or card with this application or your application will be denied. We accept a wide variety of courses, such as Hunter Safety, the NRA Basic Training courses, various safety training schools, such as FrontSight, Gunsite, Talon, etc., or IPSC or IDPA safety-check cards, National Range Officers Institute, Concealed Carry Permits, and various shooting competition Classification Cards, but a copy of your safety qualification must be enclosed. **We do not accept military recruit weapons training as safety courses.** If you need safety training we can provide you with contact information for you to arrange your own training. The training must be completed before we can accept an application.

Residents of Clear Creek County may join the club at any time. The number of club members who are residents of counties other than Clear Creek is capped at 700. Applicants must attend a one-hour range introduction to complete the application process. Once we receive your application we'll invite you to a range introduction – generally within a month or two. Note that applicants who do not reply to our contacts may be removed from our list at the 3rd failure to reply.

Do not send payment with this application. We'll collect payment at the range introduction. We have three classes of membership fees. The charges are for 12 months from March 1 to the next February 28. Fees:

1. The membership fee for non-law-enforcement officers (LEOs) is **\$80/year**. The club no longer gives a fee credit for NRA membership, but if you want to join the NRA, call 1-877-672-2000.
2. The membership fee for LE officers outside of Clear Creek County is **\$50/year**. LEOs are defined, for club purposes, as persons who possess a law enforcement ID and are authorized to carry firearms and make arrests.
3. LE officers living or based in Clear Creek County are entitled to a fee membership. If you are a LEO please send a copy of your LE identification card. Retired officers need to send a copy of their I.D. card saying "Retired."
